What and why? Homework is an essential and valuable part of the learning process.

The EEF suggest that when homework if effective and embedded it can have an impact of **+5 months** of progress particularly those in secondary schools.

Homework that is effective....

Encourages students to become **independent learners** that are **self-motivated, self-confident and resilient**.

Develops and strengthens learning activities undertaken in the classroom, and is **accessible** to all.

Enhances and extends the range and breath of the curriculum.

Has clear evidence of **feed forward**.

How do we do it

Here within our academy each year group in Key Stage 3 /4 has been provided with a Homework Timetable outlining which subjects they will receive homework from in each week of the academic year. You will notice that this has been structured so that the quantity of homework increases in each year group in both the number of subjects and the amount of time students are expected to spend on each subject.

To ensure the effectiveness of homework

Please ensure you are setting homework from the timetable. Homework set outside of the timetable adds more to the following week and blurs our sanctions as students are refusing to complete the homework. If staff miss the slot the homework is missed. The intent for homework is quality not quantity. **Please issue a L3 compulsory catch-up** for missed assessed homework. For anything else – presentation, insufficient, poor quality – contact home (no debit) – acts like a L1 warning. **Debit level 2** warnings should not be used as all of our homework is assessed.
